INTRODUCTION

God gave me a promise of positioning the church for end time revival in to structure and position the church that the glory of the latter house shall be greater than 40 pillars below based on Isaiah 60. 1- 21, 60 “Arise [from spiritual depression to a new life], shine [be radiant with the glory *and* brilliance of the LORD]; for your light has come, And the glory *and* brilliance of the LORD has risen upon you.² “For in fact, darkness will cover the earth And deep darkness *will* cover the peoples; But the LORD will rise upon you And His glory *and* brilliance will be seen on you.³ “Nations will come to your light, And kings to the brightness of your rising. ⁴ “Lift up your eyes around you and see; They all gather together, they come to you. Your sons will come from far away, And your daughters will be looked after at *their* side.⁵ “Then you will see and be radiant, And your heart will tremble [with joy] and rejoice Because the abundant wealth of the seas will ^[a]be brought to you, The wealth of the nations will come to you.⁶ “A multitude of camels [from the eastern trading tribes] will cover you [Jerusalem], The young camels of Midian and Ephah; All those from Sheba [who once came to trade] will come Bringing gold and frankincense And proclaiming the praises of the LORD.⁷ “All the flocks of Kedar will be gathered to you [as the eastern pastoral tribes join the trading tribes], The rams of Nebaioth will serve you; They will go up with acceptance [as sacrifices] on My altar, And I will glorify the house of My honor *and* splendor. ⁸ “Who are these who fly like a cloud And like doves to their windows? ⁹ “The islands *and* coastlands will confidently wait for Me; And the ships of Tarshish *will come* first, To bring your sons from far away, Their silver and gold with them, For the name of the LORD your God, For the Holy One of Israel because He has glorified you.¹⁰ “Foreigners will build up your walls, And their kings will serve you; For in My [righteous] wrath I struck you, But in My favor *and* grace I have had compassion on you. ¹¹ “Your gates will be open continually; They shall not be shut day or night, So that people may bring to you the wealth of the nations— With their kings led in procession. ¹² “For the nation or the kingdom which will not serve you [Jerusalem] shall perish, And the nations [that refuse to serve] shall be utterly ruined. ¹³ “The glory of Lebanon will come to you, The ^[b]cypress, the juniper, and the cedar together, To beautify the place of My sanctuary; And I will honor *and* make the place of My feet glorious. ¹⁴ “The sons of those who oppressed you will come bowing down to you [in submission], And all those who despised you *and* treated you disrespectfully will bow down at the soles of your feet, And they will call you the City of the LORD, The Zion of the Holy One of Israel. ¹⁵ “Whereas you [Jerusalem] have been abandoned and hated With no one passing through, I will make you an object of pride forever, A joy from generation to generation. ¹⁶ “You will suck the milk of the [Gentile] nations And suck the breast (abundance) of kings; Then you will recognize *and* know that I, the LORD, am your Savior And your Redeemer, the Mighty One of Jacob. ¹⁷ “Instead of bronze I will bring gold, And instead of iron I will bring silver, And instead of wood, bronze, And instead of stones, iron. And [instead of the tyranny of the present] I will appoint peace as your officers, And righteousness your rulers. ¹⁸ “Violence will not be heard again in your land, Nor devastation or destruction within your borders; But you will call your walls Salvation, and your gates Praise [to God]. ¹⁹ “The sun will no longer be your light by day, Nor shall the bright glow of the moon give light to you, But the LORD will be an everlasting light for you; And your God will be your glory *and* splendor. ²⁰ “Your sun will no longer set, Nor will your moon wane; For the LORD will be your everlasting light, And the days of your mourning will be over. ²¹ “Then all your people will be [uncompromisingly and consistently] righteous; They will possess the land forever, The branch of My planting, The work of My hands, That I may be glorified.

Haggai 2.2 ⁶ For thus says the LORD of hosts, ‘Once more, in a little while, I am going to shake the heavens and the earth, the sea and the dry land. ⁷ I will shake all the nations; and they will come with the desirable *and* precious things of all nations, and I will fill this house with glory *and* splendor,’ says the LORD of hosts. ⁸ ‘The silver is Mine and the gold is Mine,’ declares the LORD of hosts. ⁹ ‘The latter ^[a]glory of this house will be greater than the former,’ says the LORD of hosts, ‘and in this place I shall give [the ultimate] peace *and* prosperity,’ declares the LORD of hosts.”

4. To foster and encourage cooperation, fellowship, and mutual counsel among the churches for the purposes set forth in this Constitution
5. To assist the churches in self-examination of their life and witness in accordance with their understanding of the will of God and of the Lordship of Jesus Christ as Divine Head of the Church
6. To further works of Christian love and service throughout the nation and the world
7. To study and to speak and act on conditions and issues in the nation and the world which involve moral, ethical, and spiritual principles inherent in the Christian Gospel
8. To encourage cooperation among local churches and to further the development of councils and other organizations in agreement with the Preamble of this Constitution, and to maintain cooperative relationships with such bodies
9. To establish and maintain consultative and cooperative relationships with the kingdom Consortium of Churches and Ministries international, regional, and national ecumenical organizations; and agencies related to the churches in Kenya and Globally
10. To establish specific objectives and to carry forward programs and activities for achieving the purposes herein stated
11. To Provide mentorship education and training for minister of the gospel already in ministry and those who intend to enter in ministry through refresher courses, seminars, festivals and conferences, schools and institutions towards building and equipping ministers in church planting and growth, management, building and construction, financial empowerment and other relevant ministry subjects.
12. To Create a forum for ministers of the gospel to interact with each other and bound to sharpen, instruct, admonish, encourage and support each other in the ministry, family along with economic life's through summits retreats outings, holidays and other forums.
13. To Source and network ministers of the gospel towards opportunities to further education at all levels through Institutes College and universities locally and abroad.
14. To Organize and facilitate joint missions, prayer rallies, seminars, summits, conferences, crusades in certain regions both locally and internationally to preach the gospel and impact life's of people in all sectors of life.

19. To recommend and vetting visiting minister of the gospel coming to the nation on areas of doctrine, character and faith and advising the government and church on such accordingly to protect and defend the faith.
20. A forum of discerning evaluating and vetting of gospel ministers intun to correct and advice ministers on sound doctrine, ministerial ethics and character to build the body of Christ beyond reproach.

23. Participating with government where called upon to advice on registration of churches and ministries to facilitate unity and a basis of recommendation for missions and ministry.
24. Participate and recommend ministers of the gospel for various ordinations, honours and consecrations.
25. A forum for arbitration to resolve conflicts and disputes among ministers of the gospel a churches and ministries amicably to maintain honour in the body of Christ instead of media fights.
26. Proving a forum of being your brother and sister keepers by being involved in the welfare and events of gospel ministers of various levels.
27. Research initiate and engage in income generating projects and programs to finance and facilitate the secretariat along with other variable missions, project and programs that impact the community and the body of Christ.
28. To ensure that Pastors fellowships gather for annual Good Samaritan Festival national and county events to encourage the orphans and bring gifts we can facilitate fuel for buses.
29. To will establish charity, empowerment and development centers in counties where the body of Christ in wards, constituencies, counties, nationally and globally can be served where all our projects and projects will be implemented and invested by Helpers of Africa International 37 global agencies and 77 departments. We shall also adopt existing centers through a partnership association before we build our centers but priority will be to buy existing universities, schools, stadiums, hotels as our base for beginning the work before we construct as our home and host of our projects
30. Our heartfelt desire was to see a national and worldwide fellowship of the body of christ to serve gospel ministers, their families, spouses and children, churches, and missionary endeavors, which would sustain and maintain a strong body of believers, directed by the Holy Spirit, through Jesus Christ.
31. To serve Churches, Ministries, Missions and Religious Organizations we advice on ethics on Licensing and Ordination of Ministers, Christian Education Ministers, Pastors, Missionaries, and Individuals seeking to be in the ministry.
32. to develop a fellowship of strong believers to send out as laborers in the field for ministry, charity, empowerment and development in collaborated is to unity in the nation and internationally in a strong global network that encourages and equips for the furtherance of the Kingdom of God showing the love of God. "Sending laborers around the world armed with tools to win the lost and raising them up to reap for Christ."

33. To offer our members support and training classes to help them build their church, grow as a pastor, develop their mission organization, help them develop their boarding school, Bible college, Christian school, rescue mission, run Christian book stores and libraries/ resource centers or any other type of religious organization that is trying to win people to Jesus along with charity , empowerment and development to support humanity / kingdom of God.
34. To create focus and values based on Faith and Unity, Christian World Service acting in solidarity to good works,
35. To support in evangelism and great commission in proclaiming the gospel is called for by creating a platform for supporting one another personally, in family life, in our society and world. This involves Christ being at the centre of all we do, as well as approaching them in an holistic way.
36. To create a platform nationally and globally for the body of christ to to know each other better in all respects, including the areas of spirituality, liturgy, theology, history, sociology and culture through dinners, breakfasts, joint missions, projects and programs.
37. To create platform to reach out and show good works to people of other living faiths through projects and programs that show the love of christ to all.
38. To create platform nationally and globally for deeper understanding of faith universal matters of grace that unites us irrespective of different administrations of denominations, perceptions, world views concentrating on what unites us more than what divides us to encourage and enable member churches to develop their existing relationship by..." It requires clarification about matters like faith, our relationship with the church under oppression and persecution.
39. To Promote KCCM in public relations, the media and fund-raising for projects and programs.

To support and advocate for **value Based Education System that is innovative, transformative and holistic in church run schools through facilitation and training along with** access to retention and transition in education creating platform for publicity of recruitment to primary, secondary, college and university to promote access, retention and transition of basic education by learners, by providing them with scholarships and other educational materials and also Influencing policy and legislation in education. Influence legal and policy frameworks so as to promote quality value-based education is crucial also supporting Technical, Vocational, Education and Training in the country by influencing policy and strengthening the capacities of member churches who run technical training institutions along with supporting to Management of Learning Institutions by strengthening the capacities of boards of management of schools to enable them discharge their mandates effectively.
66.
